More Trees!?

Ok, you've all heard this before.....We planted another 50 trees. "This should just about do it for the tree plan," said Mike Piper, co-owner and "expert" tree planter. "We've added nearly 150 new tree plantings since the course opened on 2002. We expect them to take pretty well. Each tree was fertilized and watered immediately after planting. Fortunately, we had just enough rainfall the week after planting so Mother Nature did her part to help as well."

As always, tree placement is an issue that needs to be viewed from several aspects. Play ability, maintenance, irrigation are a few of the determining factors when planning exactly where a tree should be planted.

"The course designer, Greg Martin, provided us with a tree location map based on his design," commented Piper. "Our goal was to plant in as many of the recommended areas as possible."

Unlike many other courses, the layout at High Point gives golfers a "bail-out" option for the conservative player. Well, these new plantings will definitely require golfers to rethink their shot, and, in many cases, require you to "go for it" or face the consequences!

Maintenance Facility Expansion To Take Place This Winter:

The maintenance crew is doing such a great job, we decided to upgrade their maintenance facility. Upgrades will include a larger shed with an office, restroom, equipment wash area and fertilizer/chemical containment area as required by Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

The office will house the irrigation control station. Irrigation will be controlled from the maintenance office and will be able to better and more efficiently record water usage. The system will also be able to alert the superintendent if a sprinkler head is not operating properly or if there are any electrical problems, leaks or pumping problems.

Timers can be adjusted to run shorter or longer depending on course conditions and weather forecasts. This system will maximize water usage to help us survive the heat of the Midwestern Summer and improve conditions!

It's been 4 years since the opening of High Point and owners Chuck Fieldman, Mike Piper, Randy Bisailon and Chris Bisailon are eager to improve conditions and facilities to provide you with the best possible product.

"We have and will continue to try to make the course better with additional trees, driving range, upgraded maintenance facilities, and better course care. Does all this happen as fast as we want it? No, but we will continue to press this. When we first started as owners we did not have any idea what direction this venture would ultimately take us. I think we now know that this is going to be a 9-hole golf course that caters to the player looking for affordable golf in a friendly atmosphere."
